

Poisonous Snakes of the World

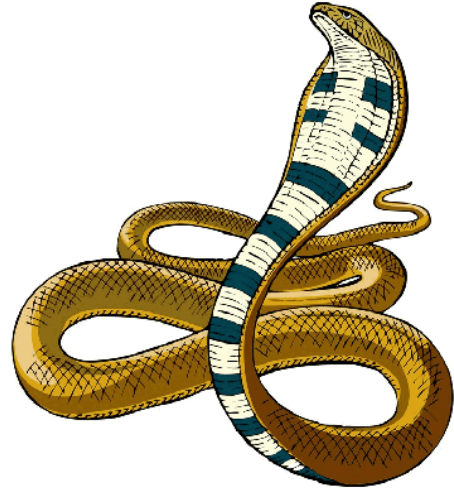
The Coral Snake is distinguished from its nonpoisonous look-alikes by its alternating yellow, red, yellow, black bands. Other species tend to have alternating black, yellow, black, red bands. The coral is the only poisonous North American snake that lays eggs.
